AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC FINANCE; AUTHORIZING THE NEW MEXICO  
FINANCE AUTHORITY TO MAKE LOANS OR GRANTS FROM THE WATER  
PROJECT FUND FOR CERTAIN WATER PROJECTS; DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF QUALIFYING WATER

PROJECTS.--Pursuant to Section 72-4A-9 NMSA 1978, the  
legislature authorizes the New Mexico finance authority to  
make loans or grants from the water project fund to the  
following qualifying entities for the following qualifying  
water projects on terms and conditions established by the  
water trust board and the New Mexico finance authority:

1. to the village of Milan in Cibola county for a  
flood prevention project;
2. to the eastern Sandoval county arroyo flood  
control authority in Sandoval county for a flood prevention  
project;
3. to the southern Sandoval county arroyo flood  
control authority in Sandoval county for a flood prevention  
project;
4. to the upper Rio Grande watershed district in  
Rio Arriba county for a flood prevention project;
5. to the city of Grants in Cibola county for a

1 flood prevention project;

2 6. to the city of Sunland Park in Dona Ana county  
3 for a flood prevention project;

4 7. to the city of Clovis in Curry county for a  
5 water conservation or treatment, recycling or reuse project;

6 8. to Los Alamos county for a water conservation  
7 or treatment, recycling or reuse project;

8 9. to the city of Gallup in McKinley county for a  
9 water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

10 10. to the city of Portales in Roosevelt county  
11 for a water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

12 11. to the Eldorado area water and sanitation  
13 district in Santa Fe county for a water storage, conveyance  
14 and delivery project;

15 12. to the El Creston mutual domestic water  
16 consumers association in San Miguel county for a water  
17 storage, conveyance and delivery project;

18 13. to the Sangre de Cristo regional mutual  
19 domestic water consumers and mutual sewage works association  
20 in Guadalupe county for a water storage, conveyance and  
21 delivery project;

22 14. to the village of Cuba in Sandoval county for  
23 a water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

24 15. to the Chapelle mutual domestic consumers  
25 association in San Miguel county for a water storage,

1 conveyance and delivery project;

2 16. to the eastern New Mexico water utility  
3 authority in Curry county for a water storage, conveyance and  
4 delivery project;

5 17. to the Buena Vista mutual domestic water  
6 consumer's and sewage works association in Mora county for a  
7 water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

8 18. to the town of Red River in Taos county for a  
9 water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

10 19. to the city of Belen in Valencia county for a  
11 water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

12 20. to the Alcalde mutual domestic water  
13 consumers' and mutual sewage works association in Rio Arriba  
14 county for a water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

15 21. to the Pena Blanca water and sanitation  
16 district in Sandoval county for a water storage, conveyance  
17 and delivery project;

18 22. to the La Cueva mutual domestic water  
19 consumers association in San Miguel county for a water  
20 storage, conveyance and delivery project;

21 23. to the lower Arroyo Hondo mutual domestic  
22 water consumers and mutual sewage works association in Taos  
23 county for a water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

24 24. to the Union del Llano mutual domestic water  
25 consumers association in Taos county for a water storage,

1 conveyance and delivery project;

2 25. to the village of Eagle Nest in Colfax county  
3 for a water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

4 26. to the city of Jal in Lea county for a water  
5 storage, conveyance and delivery project;

6 27. to the Guadalupe soil and water conservation  
7 district in Guadalupe county for a watershed restoration and  
8 management project;

9 28. to the Claunch-Pinto soil and water  
10 conservation district in Torrance county for a watershed  
11 restoration and management project in Taos, Rio Arriba, Los  
12 Alamos, Santa Fe and Sandoval counties;

13 29. to the Claunch-Pinto soil and water  
14 conservation district in Torrance county for a watershed  
15 restoration and management project; and

16 30. to the San Juan soil and water conservation  
17 district in San Juan county for a watershed restoration and  
18 management project.

19 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
20 peace, health and safety that this act take effect
