WHEREAS, public safety and emergency services are critical to the health, safety and welfare of the people of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the fire marshal division of the public regulation commission is responsible for providing communication, training, investigations, inspections, code adoption and funding to municipal and county fire departments in New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the fire marshal division is currently located within the public regulation commission, and the public regulation commission chief of staff is tasked with providing oversight for the division; and

WHEREAS, the public regulation commission is responsible for regulating public utilities, including electric, natural gas and water companies; transportation companies, including common and contract carriers; transmission and pipeline companies; including telephone, telegraph and information transmission companies and other public service companies, and there is no mention of the needed focus or support to
