#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 67 requests the Department of Health (DOH) to convene an HIV prevention and treatment task force to determine any responsibilities licensed physicians treating people with HIV at the Cibola County Correctional Center may have for reporting to DOH. The task force would also be asked to study access to HIV treatment and care to transgender women detained at the Cibola County Correctional Center.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There may be a minimal mileage and per diem costs associated with this memorial.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The Cibola County Correctional Center houses detainees under an agreement with U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.
