A MEMORIAL

DECLARING MARCH 7, 2019 "A CALL TO PRAYER FOR AMERICA DAY" IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEREAS, throughout the history of the United States, citizens have drawn strength, hope and guidance from prayer; and

WHEREAS, from the very first continental congress, through every form of adversity and blessing, Americans have fallen to their knees and implored God Almighty to protect their families and to heal their land; and

WHEREAS, the freedom upon which America was founded affords the right to any individual to decline to pray if he or she so desires; and

WHEREAS, however, the same freedom allows those who believe in the power of prayer to utilize that great

WHEREAS, in early 2005, a small group of members of the United States house of representatives began meeting in the United States capitol to pray for the nation; and

WHEREAS, their vision for the caucus inspired the members to form the congressional prayer caucus foundation, incorporated, which is a nonpartisan, nonprofit organization designed to support the call of America back to prayer; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2015, members of congress and state legislatures across America gathered for the purpose of calling the nation back to prayer, and they realized the need for America to turn back to God and prayer, not for a single day or month, but to pray "without ceasing"; and

WHEREAS, accordingly, a "call to prayer for America" is respectfully and humbly issued with an invitation to join in .214617.1
