11 DECLARING MARCH 1, 2019 "FOSTER PARENT APPRECIATION, ADVOCACY
12 AND AWARENESS DAY" IN THE SENATE.

14 WHEREAS, hundreds of New Mexicans serve as foster care
15 parents to children who are removed from their homes, through
16 no fault of their own, because the homes are not safe places
17 for them; and

18 WHEREAS, foster care parents provide unconditional love,
19 care and commitment to displaced children; and

20 WHEREAS, according to the children, youth and families
21 department, in fiscal year 2018, there were two thousand five
22 hundred thirty-one children in foster care; and

23 WHEREAS, foster care parents participated in three hundred
24 eleven finalized adoptions; and

25 WHEREAS, foster care parents are ready to receive a child

7 stability and security of those children; and

8 WHEREAS, foster care parents open their homes and their
9 hearts to children who need love and support, while respecting
10 and fostering connections to the children's culture, religion
11 and community; and

12 WHEREAS, foster care parents help children in foster care
13 realize they are not alone and that others care for them; and

14 WHEREAS, foster care parents help children build self-
15 esteem and confidence and provide structure that will
16 contribute to healthy and engaging lives; and

17 WHEREAS, foster care parents have the joy and privilege of
18 parenting and learning from children who did not decide to be
19 placed under the state's care, but like all children, have so
20 much to offer;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE
22 OF NEW MEXICO that March 1, 2019 be declared "Foster Parent
23 Appreciation, Advocacy and Awareness Day" in the senate; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
25 transmitted to the secretary of children, youth and families.
