AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUEBLO OF ZUNI EDUCATION-RELATED IMPROVEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. The following amounts are appropriated to the Indian affairs department for expenditure in fiscal years 2021 and 2022 for the following purposes for the Pueblo of Zuni to comply with the findings in the consolidated Yazzie/Martinez v. State of New Mexico lawsuit:

(\$150,000) to provide college scholarships for members of the Pueblo of Zuni who want to be teachers; provided that scholarships available under this paragraph shall be last-resort scholarships that make up the difference between lottery

tuition scholarships or other financial aid and the cost of tuition and fees at a New Mexico public post-secondary educational institution or a New Mexico tribal college that offers bachelor's degrees in education;

- (\$350,000) to develop culturally and linguistically relevant curriculum and instructional materials for use in New Mexico public schools;
- (\$150,000) to provide social services, behavioral health services and suicide prevention and intervention services to Zuni youth; and
- (4) one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to develop community profiles, college and career readiness and workforce alignments.
- B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2022 shall revert to the general fund.
