

HOUSE TAXATION AND REVENUE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL 355

54TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2020

AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR
REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING OR CHANGING PURPOSES,
EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CHANGING AGENCIES AND
ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OR TRANSFER OF
UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE LEGISLATURE
IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
bonding fund:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or
7 the time frame set forth in any law that has previously
8 reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is
9 later; and

10 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
11 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
12 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
13 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the
14 unexpended balances.

15 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 **SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--**
20 **REVERSIONS.--**

21 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
22 of this act:

23 (1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation
24 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
25 in this act shall revert:

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1 (a) at the end of the expenditure period
2 as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is changed
3 in this act; or

4 (b) if the expenditure period is not
5 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
6 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the
7 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed the
8 appropriation, whichever is later; and

9 (2) all remaining balances of an appropriation
10 from the general fund or other state fund that has been changed
11 in this act shall revert three months after the reversion date
12 for the unexpended balance.

13 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this
14 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general
15 fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to Subsection A
16 of this section to the originating fund.

17 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the
18 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
19 department or the aging and long-term services department for a
20 project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo
21 shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section to the
22 tribal infrastructure project fund.

23 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
24 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
25 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding

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1 written obligations to third parties.

2 **SECTION 3. PASEO DEL VOLCAN LOOP BYPASS--EXTEND TIME--**
3 **SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the
4 department of transportation project originally authorized in
5 Subsection 57 of Section 25 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to
6 acquire rights of way for and to plan, design and construct the
7 paseo del Volcan loop bypass road from Unser boulevard to
8 interstate highway 40 in Bernalillo and Sandoval counties and
9 for which the time of expenditure was extended in Laws 2018,
10 Chapter 68, Section 3 is extended through fiscal year 2022.

11 **SECTION 4. PASEO DEL VOLCAN RIGHTS OF WAY ACQUISITION IN**
12 **BERNALILLO AND SANDOVAL COUNTIES--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX**
13 **BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the department of
14 transportation project in Subsection 1 of Section 24 of Chapter
15 81 of Laws 2016 to acquire rights of way and to design and
16 construct paseo del Volcan, also known as New Mexico highway
17 347, in Sandoval and Bernalillo counties is extended through
18 fiscal year 2022.

19 **SECTION 5. ROUTE 66 VISITORS CENTER ON WEST CENTRAL**
20 **AVENUE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
21 expenditure for the local government division project
22 originally authorized in Subsection 17 of Section 22 of Chapter
23 66 of Laws 2014 and reauthorized in Laws 2018, Chapter 68,
24 Section 11 to purchase, plan, construct, furnish and equip a
25 Route 66 visitors center on west Central avenue in Bernalillo

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1 county is extended through fiscal year 2022.

2 **SECTION 6. SOUTH VALLEY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CENTER**
3 IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
4 expenditure for the local government division project
5 originally authorized in Subsection 18 of Section 22 of Chapter
6 66 of Laws 2014 and reauthorized in Laws 2018, Chapter 68,
7 Section 12 to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish
8 improvements and additions to the South Valley economic
9 development center in Bernalillo county is extended through
10 fiscal year 2022.

11 **SECTION 7. SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT HIGH-DENSITY**
12 FILE STORAGE UNITS PURCHASE--CHANGE TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AND
13 FOR RENOVATIONS TO THE FIRST THROUGH THIRD FLOORS OF THE SECOND
14 JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURTHOUSE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
15 BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the second judicial district
16 court project in Laws 2018, Chapter 80, Section 14 to purchase
17 and install high-density file storage units and to purchase
18 related equipment for the second judicial district court shall
19 not be used for the original purpose but is changed for
20 security equipment, renovations and structural alterations and
21 to purchase fixed and mobile equipment, furnishings and
22 technology for the renovation of the first through third floors
23 of the second judicial district courthouse in Albuquerque in
24 Bernalillo county. The time of expenditure is extended through
25 fiscal year 2022.

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1 **SECTION 8. ALBUQUERQUE BIOPARK JAGUAR EXHIBIT CONSTRUCT--**
2 **EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for
3 the local government division project originally authorized in
4 Subsection 25 of Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 and
5 reauthorized in Laws 2018, Chapter 68, Section 15 to design and
6 construct a jaguar exhibit at the biopark in Albuquerque in
7 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2022.

8 **SECTION 9. ALBUQUERQUE EXPLORA SCIENCE CENTER AND**
9 **CHILDREN'S MUSEUM LEARNING CENTER CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--**
10 **SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the local
11 government division project in Subsection 21 of Section 22 of
12 Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan, design, construct, equip and
13 furnish phase 1 of Explora's cradle to career learning center
14 and to purchase and install exhibits, furnishings and equipment
15 for the Explora science center and children's museum in
16 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
17 year 2022.

18 **SECTION 10. ALBUQUERQUE GUN VIOLENCE MEMORIAL--EXTEND**
19 **TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the
20 cultural affairs department project in Subsection 1 of Section
21 8 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan, design, construct and
22 install a memorial to gun violence victims in Albuquerque in
23 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2022.

24 **SECTION 11. TRUMBULL AVENUE AND SAN PEDRO DRIVE STREET**
25 **LIGHTS INSTALLATION--CHANGE TO ALBUQUERQUE INTERNATIONAL**

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1 DISTRICT STREET LIGHTS INSTALLATION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
 2 BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to the
 3 department of transportation originally authorized in
 4 Subsection 17 of Section 25 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 and
 5 reauthorized in Laws 2018, Chapter 68, Section 34 to purchase
 6 and install street lights along Trumbull avenue SE and San
 7 Pedro drive SE in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be
 8 expended for the original purpose but is changed to purchase
 9 and install street lights in the International district in
 10 Albuquerque. The time of expenditure is extended through
 11 fiscal year 2022.

12 SECTION 12. ALBUQUERQUE ASIAN AND PACIFIC ISLANDER
 13 SHELTER CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO COMMUNITY CENTER CONSTRUCTION--
 14 GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance of the appropriation to
 15 the local government division in Subsection 31 of Section 34 of
 16 Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design and construct a
 17 shelter for victims of domestic violence and survivors of
 18 sexual assault among the Asian and Pacific Islander population
 19 in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for
 20 the original purpose but is changed to plan, design and
 21 construct a city-owned community center inclusive of the
 22 cultural needs of the Asian and Pacific Islander population in
 23 Albuquerque.

24 SECTION 13. ALBUQUERQUE MOBILE VIDEO TRAILER PURCHASE--
 25 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for
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1 the local government division project in Subsection 33 of
2 Section 26 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to purchase mobile video
3 trailers for Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended
4 through fiscal year 2022.

5 SECTION 14. ALBUQUERQUE SIGN LANGUAGE ACADEMY

6 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
7 expenditure for the public education department project in
8 Subsection 1 of Section 14 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan,
9 design and construct a facility for the Albuquerque sign
10 language academy in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is
11 extended through fiscal year 2022.

12 SECTION 15. AMY BIEHL HIGH SCHOOL ASBESTOS AND LEAD PAINT

13 ABATEMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
14 expenditure for the public education department project in
15 Subsection 2 of Section 14 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 for
16 asbestos and lead paint abatement and to plan, design,
17 construct and renovate the basement at Amy Biehl high school in
18 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
19 year 2022.

20 SECTION 16. ATRISCO HERITAGE ACADEMY HIGH SCHOOL ACCESS

21 ROAD CONSTRUCTION--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
22 BONDS.--The department of transportation project in Subsection
23 7 of Section 24 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan, design and
24 construct an access road to Atrisco Heritage academy high
25 school, including driveways, trail connections and

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1 modifications to Senator Dennis Chavez boulevard and to 118th
 2 street, in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county may include
 3 sidewalks and signal modifications. The time of expenditure is
 4 extended through fiscal year 2022.

5 **SECTION 17. BERNALILLO COUNTY ASIAN AMERICAN MONUMENT**
 6 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
 7 expenditure for the local government division project in
 8 Subsection 45 of Section 22 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan,
 9 design, landscape and construct an Asian American monument in
 10 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
 11 year 2022.

12 **SECTION 18. BERNALILLO COUNTY ROUTE 66 VISITOR CENTER ON**
 13 WEST CENTRAL AVENUE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
 14 time of expenditure for the local government division project
 15 in Subsection 52 of Section 22 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to
 16 acquire land for and to plan, design, construct, purchase,
 17 furnish and equip a route 66 visitor center on west Central
 18 avenue in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through
 19 fiscal year 2022.

20 **SECTION 19. LOS PUENTES CHARTER SCHOOL PORTABLE BUILDING**
 21 CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO LOS PUENTES CHARTER SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION
 22 AND EQUIPPING OF BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS AND INSTALLATION OF
 23 INFRASTRUCTURE--GENERAL FUND.--The unexpended balance of the
 24 appropriation to the public education department in Subsection
 25 117 of Section 20 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design,

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1 construct, improve, equip and furnish a portable classroom
2 building at Los Puentes charter school in the Albuquerque
3 public school district in Bernalillo county shall not be
4 expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,
5 design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip buildings and
6 grounds and install related equipment, fencing, education and
7 information technology, wiring, paving and infrastructure for
8 Los Puentes charter school in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

9 SECTION 20. NATIONAL HISPANIC CULTURAL CENTER INFORMATION
10 AND WELCOME CENTER CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
11 BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the cultural affairs
12 department project originally authorized in Subsection 3 of
13 Section 7 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 to plan, design,
14 construct, equip and furnish an information and welcome center
15 at the entrance of the national Hispanic cultural center in
16 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county and for which the time of
17 expenditure was extended in Laws 2018, Chapter 68, Section 33
18 is extended through fiscal year 2021.

19 SECTION 21. SOUTH VALLEY PREPARATORY SCHOOL PORTABLES
20 PURCHASE--EXPAND PURPOSE--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The public
21 education department project in Subsection 13 of Section 16 of
22 Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to acquire land and to plan, design,
23 construct, purchase, equip and install portable classrooms at
24 the South Valley preparatory school in Albuquerque in
25 Bernalillo county may include planning, designing, renovating,

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1 equipping, furnishing and purchasing buildings and equipment
2 for that school.

3 **SECTION 22. UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**
4 **MULTIPURPOSE EVENTS CENTER RENOVATION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE**
5 **TAX BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the board of regents of
6 the university of New Mexico project in Subsection 1 of Section
7 13 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan, design, construct and
8 renovate a former church building as a multipurpose events
9 center for a cooperative economic development project between
10 Innovate ABQ, incorporated, and the university of New Mexico in
11 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
12 year 2022.

13 **SECTION 23. HIGHLAND HIGH SCHOOL OUTDOOR ADVENTURE CLUB**
14 **VAN PURCHASE--CHANGE TO HIGHLAND HIGH SCHOOL AND ALBUQUERQUE**
15 **PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT OUTDOOR TRAILER PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--**
16 **GENERAL FUND.--**The unexpended balance of the public education
17 department project in Subsection 94 of Section 20 of Chapter
18 277 of Laws 2019 to purchase and equip an activity van for
19 Highland high school in the Albuquerque public school district
20 in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original
21 purpose but is changed to purchase and equip a trailer and
22 outdoor education equipment for Highland high school and
23 throughout the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo
24 county. The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal
25 year 2022.

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1 **SECTION 24. MARY ANN BINFORD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TRACK AREA**
2 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
3 expenditure for the public education department project in
4 Subsection 111 of Section 14 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to
5 plan, design, renovate and construct improvements to the
6 grounds, fields and track areas, including the purchase and
7 installation of related equipment, furniture and landscaping,
8 at Mary Ann Binford elementary school in the Albuquerque public
9 school district in Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
10 year 2022.

11 **SECTION 25. ROBERT F. KENNEDY CHARTER SCHOOL LEARNING**
12 LABORATORY EQUIPMENT--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
13 time of expenditure for the public education department project
14 in Subsection 116 of Section 16 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to
15 purchase and install equipment for a virtual learning
16 laboratory at Robert F. Kennedy charter school in the
17 Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county is
18 extended through fiscal year 2022.

19 **SECTION 26. ROBERT F. KENNEDY CHARTER SCHOOL INFORMATION**
20 TECHNOLOGY PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
21 time of expenditure for the public education department project
22 in Subsection 115 of Section 16 of Chapter 80 of Laws 2018 to
23 purchase and install information technology, including related
24 equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at Robert F. Kennedy
25 charter school in the Albuquerque public school district in

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1 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2022.

2 **SECTION 27. ROBERT F. KENNEDY CHARTER SCHOOL LEARNING**
3 **LABORATORY EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX**
4 **BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the local government
5 division project originally authorized in Subsection 62 of
6 Section 22 of Chapter 66 of Laws 2014 for a community center in
7 the Westgate community in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county and
8 appropriated to the public education department in Laws 2018,
9 Chapter 68, Section 36 to purchase and install equipment for a
10 virtual learning laboratory at Robert F. Kennedy charter school
11 in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county
12 is extended through fiscal year 2022.

13 **SECTION 28. TO'HAJIILEE CHAPTER SKATEBOARD AND**
14 **RECREATIONAL PARK PLANNING, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION--CHANGE TO**
15 **PURCHASE BACKHOE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The
16 unexpended balance of the appropriation to the Indian affairs
17 department in Subsection 2 of Section 20 of Chapter 81 of Laws
18 2016 to plan, design and construct a skateboard and
19 recreational park, including purchase and installation of
20 furnishings and equipment, in the To'hajiilee chapter of the
21 Navajo Nation in Bernalillo county shall not be expended for
22 the original purpose but is changed to purchase a backhoe for
23 the To'hajiilee chapter. The time of expenditure is extended
24 through fiscal year 2022.

25 **SECTION 29. DEXTER WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT--EXTEND**

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1 TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the
2 department of environment project originally authorized in
3 Subsection 5 of Section 18 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 and
4 reauthorized in Laws 2018, Chapter 68, Section 38 to plan,
5 design and construct water system improvements, including
6 wells, water supply lines and water treatment, in Dexter in
7 Chaves county is extended through fiscal year 2022.

8 SECTION 30. CIBOLA COUNTY HEAVY EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--
9 EXPAND PURPOSE--GENERAL FUND.--The local government division
10 project in Subsection 150 of Section 34 of Chapter 277 of Laws
11 2019 to purchase and equip heavy equipment, including a
12 skidsteer, for Cibola county may include purchasing and
13 equipping vehicles and other equipment.

14 SECTION 31. ACOMA PUEBLO WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY
15 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
16 expenditure for the department of environment project in
17 Subsection 6 of Section 18 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan,
18 design and construct expansions and upgrades to the North
19 Acomita wastewater treatment facility at the Pueblo of Acoma in
20 Cibola county is extended through fiscal year 2022.

21 SECTION 32. RAMAH CHAPTER SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION
22 PLANNING, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX
23 BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the Indian affairs
24 department project in Subsection 6 of Section 20 of Chapter 81
25 of Laws 2016 to plan, design and construct a solid waste

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1 transfer station, including a trash compactor dumpster, a trash
2 bin and an operator building, in the Ramah chapter of the
3 Navajo Nation in Cibola county is extended through fiscal year
4 2022.

5 **SECTION 33. ANGEL FIRE WATER STORAGE TANKS CONSTRUCTION**
6 **AND REPAIR--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
7 expenditure for the department of environment project in
8 Subsection 7 of Section 18 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan,
9 design, construct and repair water storage tanks in Angel Fire
10 in Colfax county is extended through fiscal year 2022.

11 **SECTION 34. MINERS' HOSPITAL LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY**
12 **ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS--EXPAND PURPOSE--**
13 **EXTEND TIME--MINERS' TRUST FUND.--**The miners' Colfax medical
14 center project in Subsection 3 of Section 39 of Chapter 81 of
15 Laws 2016 to plan, design, construct, renovate, equip and
16 furnish mechanical and electrical system upgrades and
17 improvements at the center's long-term care facility in Colfax
18 county may include upgrades and improvements at the center's
19 acute care facility. The time of expenditure is extended
20 through fiscal year 2022.

21 **SECTION 35. EASTERN NEW MEXICO FOOD BANK LIGHTING**
22 **IMPROVEMENTS--EXPAND PURPOSE--GENERAL FUND.--**The local
23 government division project in Subsection 164 of Section 34 of
24 Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to plan, design, construct and install
25 improvements to lighting at a food bank for eastern New Mexico

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1 in Clovis in Curry county may include planning, designing and
2 constructing improvements, including paving and a parking lot,
3 at the food bank.

4 SECTION 36. CLOVIS RAILROAD DISTRICT ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND
5 SANTA FE LOCOMOTIVE REPAIRING AND RESTORATION--EXPAND PURPOSE--
6 EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The local government
7 division project in Subsection 76 of Section 22 of Chapter 81
8 of Laws 2016 to repair and restore the Atchison, Topeka and
9 Santa Fe 9005 locomotive in the railroad district in Clovis in
10 Curry county may include repairing and restoring a caboose.
11 The time of expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2022.

12 SECTION 37. BOSQUE REDONDO MEMORIAL IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND
13 TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of expenditure for the
14 cultural affairs department project in Subsection 4 of Section
15 8 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan, design, construct,
16 landscape and improve the Bosque Redondo memorial at the Fort
17 Sumner historic site in De Baca county is extended through
18 fiscal year 2022.

19 SECTION 38. DONA ANA COUNTY RADIUM SPRINGS FIRE STATION 8
20 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
21 expenditure for the local government division project in
22 Subsection 89 of Section 22 of Chapter 81 of Laws 2016 to plan,
23 design and construct improvements to Radium Springs fire
24 station 8 in Dona Ana county is extended through fiscal year
25 2022.

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1 **SECTION 39. LOWER RIO GRANDE PUBLIC WATER WORKS AUTHORITY**
2 MINI-EXCAVATOR PURCHASE--EXPAND PURPOSE--GENERAL FUND.--The
3 department of environment project in Subsection 24 of Section
4 26 of Chapter 277 of Laws 2019 to purchase and equip a mini-
