Section 9-5B-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1992, Chapter 91, Section 6, as amended) is amended to read: 11 "9-5B-6. COMMISSION--POWERS AND DUTIES.--12 13 Α. The commission may: accept gifts, devises, grants and 14 (1) 15 donations from others to carry out the provisions of the New Mexico Youth Conservation Corps Act; 16 (2) request assistance and staff support 17 from the department; 18 (3) employ such personnel as necessary to 19 20 carry out the provisions of the New Mexico Youth Conservation Corps Act; 21 (4) delegate responsibility for the 22 administration and implementation of conservation projects, 23 corps members' employment and supervision, project 24 coordination and other program matters; HB 304/a 25 Page 1

1	(5) establish work camps and long-term

6	B. The commission shall:	
7	(1) adopt rules that are necessary for the	
8	proper administration of the New Mexico Youth Conservation	
9	Corps Act;	
10	(2) administer and enforce the provisions of	
11	the New Mexico Youth Conservation Corps Act and rules adopted	
12	pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this subsection;	
13	(3) develop and approve corps work projects,	
14	activities and contracts with project sponsors;	
15	(4) establish standards, procedures and	
16	policies for selecting, hiring, providing compensation for	
17	and other personnel matters involving corps members and other	
18	personnel;	
19	(5) foster partnerships and cooperation	
20	between the corps and New Mexico's secondary and post-	
21	secondary schools to assist corps members in obtaining	
22	education and job training; and	
23	(6) hire a program manager, who shall be the	
24	administrative officer of the corps."

15	(3) promote stewardship and preservation of

19	(5) administer the outdoor equity grant

21	B. The department, the tourism department, the
22	state land office, the Rio Grande trail commission, the state

department of health and the department of transportation shall work in conjunction with the New Mexico outdoor recreation division to support the division's duties as they relate to the purposes of the respective departments and agencies.

C. For the purposes of administering functions of the New Mexico outdoor recreation division:

8 (1) "ecotourism" means a form of tourism
9 that involves visiting areas of ecological interest and is
10 intended as a low-impact and often small-scale alternative to
11 standard commercial tourism; and

12 (2) "outdoor recreation" means a 13 recreational activity that occurs outdoors in a natural 14 environment, including the use of trails, the natural 15 landscape, water or snow resources or other natural resources 16 in the activity."

SECTION 4. Section 9-5B-10.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2019, Chapter 117, Section 7) is recompiled as part of the Economic Development Department Act and is amended to read:

20 "OUTDOOR EQUITY GRANT PROGRAM--CREATED--ADMINISTRATION--21 GRANT CRITERIA.--

A. The "outdoor equity grant program" is created in the department to be administered by the New Mexico outdoor recreation division of the department.

B. Each fiscal year, competitive grants shall be

awarded to applicants for the sole purpose of funding outdoor recreation programs, in whole or in part, for youth up to the age of eighteen.

C. Political subdivisions of the state, Indian nations, tribes and pueblos and nonprofit organizations may apply for outdoor equity grants.

D. Annually, the New Mexico outdoor recreation 8 division shall establish a minimum and maximum number of grants available based on the funding appropriated to the outdoor equity grant program fund for that fiscal year.

Ε. The New Mexico outdoor recreation division 11 shall award grants to applicants through a competitive 12 process and based upon the following minimum criteria: 13

(1) at least forty percent of the population 14 served by the applicant are low-income youth up to the age of 15 eighteen; 16

(2) the applicant has a well-developed, 17 written plan to engage low-income youth in outdoor recreation 18 activities; and 19

(3) the applicant has an educational plan to 20 educate youth about climate and the environment as part of 21 its outdoor recreation program. 22

F. The New Mexico outdoor recreation division 23 shall establish grant reporting requirements that meet the 24 general purpose of this section." 25

SECTION 5. Section 9-5B-10.2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2019, Chapter 117, Section 8) is recompiled as part of the Economic Development Department Act and is amended to read: "OUTDOOR EQUITY GRANT PROGRAM FUND--CREATED.--

The "outdoor equity grant program fund" is Α. created in the state treasury. All appropriations, gifts, devises, grants and donations received shall be deposited in the fund. Money in the fund is appropriated to the department for the New Mexico outdoor recreation division to carry out the outdoor equity grant program. Any money appropriated to the fund or accruing to it through gifts, grants, bequests or interest shall remain in the fund. Money in the fund shall not revert at the end of a fiscal year.

Β. The fund shall be administered by the 14 department. Disbursements from the fund shall be made only 15 upon warrant drawn by the secretary of finance and 16 administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the secretary of economic development or the secretary's designee for the purpose of carrying out the outdoor equity grant program."

SECTION 6. TEMPORARY PROVISION--TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS, RECORDS AND CONTRACTS TO THE NEW MEXICO OUTDOOR RECREATION DIVISION OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT.--On the effective date of this act:

Α. all functions, appropriations, money, records and files of the New Mexico youth conservation corps

1	commission relating to the outdoor equity grant program shall	
2	be transferred to the New Mexico outdoor recreation division	
3	of the economic development department;	
4	B. all contractual obligations of the New Mexico	
5	youth conservation corps commission relating to the outdoor	
6	equity grant program shall be binding on the New Mexico

8	C. the rules, orders and decisions of the New	
9	Mexico youth conservation corps commission relating to the	
10	outdoor equity grant program shall remain in effect until
