### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 20 renames a bridge located on interstate 40, exit 131, in To'Hajiilee after Private First Class Raymond Platero.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Pursuant to STC Policy No. 61, Memorial or Honorary Designation or Dedication of Highways, Transportation Facilities and Structures (CP 61), the STC may take action to name a bridge after Private First Class Raymond Platero. If the STC takes such action, NMDOT would be responsible to bear the cost of production, installation and maintenance of the signs for the dedication made by the STC. In response to a prior year request for similar information, the Department of Transportation estimated the cost associated with production and installation of two signs to designate a portion of roadway is approximately \$1 thousand.
