### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Memorial 61 (HM61) requests the Department of Health (DOH) and the Human Services Department (HSD) collect data about the provision of care coordination services by the Centennial Care 2.0 Medicaid managed care organizations (MCOs), and gaps in these services for individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

HM61 requests DOH and HSD report their findings to the Legislative Health and Human Services Committee by October 1, 2020.

Copies of HM61 will be transmitted to the Governor, the Chair of the Legislative Health and Human Services Committee, the Attorney General, the State Auditor, and the secretaries of the Department of Health and Human Services Department.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

HM61 does not include an appropriation.

The Human Services Department (HSD) indicates HM61 will require HSD staff to work with the Medicaid MCOs to develop the reporting template and technical specifications.

**SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

HSD reports as of January 2020, there were approximately 5,500 Medicaid managed care members who receive their Medicaid home- and community-based services through the Developmental Disabilities, Mi Via, or Medically Fragile Medicaid waivers. An additional 3,000 Medicaid managed care members are on the waiting list for the Developmental Disabilities (DD) Medicaid waiver.

**RELATIONSHIP**

HM61 relates to an appropriation in the General Appropriation Act of 2020 for the Developmental Disabilities Medicaid Waiver in DOH; and the home and community based services under the Medicaid program in HSD.
