Synopsis of SRC Amendments

The Senate Rules Committee amendments to Senate Joint Memorial 8 adds language to include the president of the United States Senate, and the secretary of Indian Affairs as recipients of the memorial. The amendment also clarifies that the memorial be delivered to the presidents of the Mescalero and Apache Tribes, and the chair of the All Pueblo Council of Governors.

Synopsis of Original Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 8 resolves that the New Mexico Legislature request the United States Congress to take affirmative steps to forward fund the higher education grant program of the Bureau of Indian Education. SJM8 further resolves that copies of the memorial be transmitted to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the New Mexico congressional delegation, the Navajo Nation Office of the President and Vice President, the Navajo Nation Council, the Jicarilla Apache Tribe, the Mescalero Apache Tribe and the All Pueblo Council of Governors.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Senate Joint Memorial 8 does not include an appropriation.
