BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Five million dollars

(\$5,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the human services department for expenditure in fiscal year 2022
