SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

As shown by the attached table compiled by the Legislative Council Service, the governor vetoed 423 bills presented by the legislature in the years 2010 to 2020. Of these, 221 bills, or more than half of the vetoed bills, were not approved, i.e. were pocket vetoed, after the legislature adjourned.

The office of the Governor opposes SJR2's provisions that would eliminate the governor's pocket veto authority and contends that eliminating the governor's pocket veto authority would be a significant intrusion into the governor's executive authority and would disrupt the balance of power contemplated by the New Mexico Constitution. The office states that the pocket veto has been included in the governor's constitutional powers for over 100 years. Many other states have similar constitutional pocket veto powers,¹ as does the President of the United States. *See* U.S. Const. Art. I, Sec. 7. SJR2 removes the governor's discretion to sign, formally veto, or pocket veto a bill presented in the last three days of the legislative session. There may be number of reasons for a governor to choose to pocket veto a bill rather than formally veto it. A governor's constitutionally valued discretion should not be removed from the veto power conferred by the state constitution.

Office of the Governor believes SJR2 further infringes on the governor's veto power by creating a new requirement that the governor provide a written explanation for every veto. According to the office, the requirement would chill a governor's use of the veto power by creating an unnecessary burden to explain every veto. The office also points out that there is no similar requirement for each legislator to provide written explanations for every vote against a bill. Nor should there be, as legislators held accountable by their constituents with requests from the press for an explanation for a vote against a bill. The governor is similarly held accountable by New Mexicans with statements regarding positions on bills communicated to the press.

Finally, the office notes that SJR2 would not guarantee any additional transparency, which appears to be the intent of the measure, as there are no enforceable standards for the explanation. The explanation could be simple as "Governor disapproves of the bill" or "Governor vetoed the bill according to her conscience." Accordingly, the proposed amendment would simply create an unnecessary burden with no corresponding benefit.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

The office states that SJR2's provisions eliminating the pocket veto and requiring an explanation of all vetoes would impose a significant burden on the governor's office each year, as most bills that are passed in the last three days of the legislation already require substantial time and resources to analyze.
