MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO FUND THE IMPROVEMENT AND RENOVATION OF A FACILITY FOR THE EXPANSION OF INTEGRATED SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER PROGRAMS AND CLINICS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Nine hundred seventeen

thousand eight hundred dollars (\$917,800) is appropriated from the consumer settlement fund of the office of the attorney general to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years 2022 through 2024 to fund the improvement and renovation of a facility for the expansion of integrated substance use disorder programs in San Miguel county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2024 shall revert to the HHHC→general←HHHC HHHC→consumer settlement←HHHC fund.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
