## AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF SCHOOL NURSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. One million dollars (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the public education department for expenditure in fiscal year 2023 to increase the number of .221374.1AIC January 28, 2022 (4:24pm)

school nurses. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2023 shall revert to the general fund.

- As used in this section, "school nurse" means a person who:
- is a nurse authorized pursuant to the Nursing Practice Act to practice as a professional registered nurse;
- is licensed by the SEC→public (2) education←SEC SEC→department and the←SEC board of nursing as a SEC→school←SEC nurse; and
- (3) provides services as a school nurse at a school.
