SENATE BILL 125

has had it under consideration and reports same with recommendation that it **DO PASS**, amended as follows:

- 1. On page 1, line 12, after "EMPLOYEES", insert ", CERTAIN HIGHER EDUCATION EMPLOYEES AND LICENSED AND NONLICENSED EMPLOYEES OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS OR STATE-CHARTERED CHARTER SCHOOLS; PROVIDING FOR A TWO PERCENT ANNUAL MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE".
- 2. On page 1, line 18, before "person", insert "state employee, licensed and nonlicensed employee of a school district and state-chartered charter school and every".
- 3. On page 1, line 23, strike "four hundred" and strike lines 24 and 25 in their entirety.
- 4. On page 2, line 1, strike "rate equal to at least" and after the period, insert the following new subsections:
- "B. Any salary increases pursuant to the provisions of Subsection A of this section shall be effective the first full pay period beginning on or after July 1, 2022.
- C. Beginning July 1, 2023 and each subsequent July 1, the minimum wage rate for state employees shall increase by two percent annually.".
