11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES  
12 DEPARTMENT FOR THE CREATION OF A ONE-STOP FAMILY CENTER IN DONA  
13 ANA COUNTY THAT PROVIDES SOCIAL SERVICES RELATED TO FOOD,  
14 HOUSING, HEALTH CARE, TRANSPORTATION, PARENTAL SUPPORT,  
15 EDUCATION AND MENTORING.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

18 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Four million seven hundred  
19 sixty thousand dollars (\$4,760,000) is appropriated from the  
20 general fund to the children, youth and families department for  
21 expenditure in fiscal years 2023 through 2025 to create a one-  
22 stop family center in Dona Ana county that provides social  
23 services related to food, housing, health care, transportation,  
24 parental support, education and mentoring. Any unexpended or  
25 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2025
