created in the state treasury. The human services department shall administer the fund, and money in the fund is appropriated to that department to provide statewide substance use disorder treatment. Money in the fund shall be disbursed on warrants signed by the secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the secretary of human services or the secretary's authorized representative. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall revert to the general fund. SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2022. - 2 -.221919.1
