6 of Pecos, New Mexico; and

7 WHEREAS, the son of Teodolo and Escolastica Flores,  
8 Reynaldo was born in Pecos on September 29, 1933; and

9 WHEREAS, after graduating from Pecos high school,  
10 Reynaldo joined the United States air force; and

11 WHEREAS, Reynaldo served from July 1951 to January 1955  
12 as a military police officer during the Korean conflict; and

13 WHEREAS, Reynaldo completed his service at Cannon air  
14 force base in Clovis; and

15 WHEREAS, Reynaldo married Flora Algien on August 18,  
16 1956, and together they raised five children: Donna,  
17 Michael, Donald, Renee and Douglas; and

18 WHEREAS, in 1956, Reynaldo began his career in New  
19 Mexico state government at the penitentiary of New Mexico;  
20 and

21 WHEREAS, Reynaldo moved on to work at the state highway  
22 and transportation department in 1968 and returned to the  
23 penitentiary of New Mexico in 1970; and

24 WHEREAS, Reynaldo was a guard on duty during the  
25 violent riot at the penitentiary of New Mexico on February 2

1 and 3, 1980; and

2 WHEREAS, Reynaldo's career and service to the state of  
3 New Mexico spanned thirty years;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF  
5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that Reynaldo  
6 Miguel Flores be honored and recognized for his exemplary  
7 service to New Mexico; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be
