AN ACT

RELATING TO FINANCE; AUTHORIZING THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE
AUTHORITY TO MAKE LOANS OR GRANTS FROM THE WATER PROJECT FUND
FOR CERTAIN WATER PROJECTS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF QUALIFYING WATER

PROJECTS.--Pursuant to Section 72-4A-9 NMSA 1978, the
legislature authorizes the New Mexico finance authority to
make loans or grants from the water project fund to the
following qualifying entities for the following qualifying
water projects on terms and conditions established by the
water trust board and the New Mexico finance authority:

1. to the city of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county
for three water conservation, treatment, recycling or reuse
projects;

2. to the Albuquerque-Bernalillo county water
utility authority in Bernalillo county for two water
conservation, treatment, recycling or reuse projects;

3. to the city of Anthony in Dona Ana county for
a flood prevention project;

4. to the town of Bernalillo in Sandoval county
for a water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

5. to the Canada de los Alamos mutual domestic
water consumers' and mutual sewage works association in

1 Santa Fe county for a water storage, conveyance and delivery
2 project;

3 6. to the eastern New Mexico water utility
4 authority in Curry county for a water storage, conveyance and
5 delivery project;

6 7. to the Eldorado area water and sanitation
7 district in Santa Fe county for a water storage, conveyance
8 and delivery project;

9 8. to the EMWT regional water association in
10 Torrance county for a water storage, conveyance and delivery
11 project;

12 9. to the energy, minerals and natural resources
13 department for a watershed restoration and management project
14 in Socorro county;

15 10. to the greater Chimayo mutual domestic water
16 consumers association in Santa Fe county for a water storage,
17 conveyance and delivery project;

18 11. to the interstate stream commission for a
19 federal Endangered Species Act implementation project in
20 Bernalillo county;

21 12. to La Jara mutual domestic water consumers
22 and mutual sewage works association in Sandoval county for a
23 water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

24 13. to the Lincoln mutual domestic water consumers
25 association and Lincoln sewage works in Lincoln county for a

1 water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

2 14. to Los Alamos county for a water conservation,
3 treatment, recycling or reuse project;

4 15. to Luna county for a flood prevention project;

5 16. to the middle Rio Grande conservancy district
6 in Bernalillo county for a water storage, conveyance and
7 delivery project;

8 17. to the village of Milan in Cibola county for
9 a flood prevention project and a water storage, conveyance
10 and delivery project;

11 18. to the New Mexico new model community ditch
12 association in Hidalgo county for a water storage, conveyance
13 and delivery project;

14 19. to the Quail Hollow mutual domestic water
15 users association in Bernalillo county for a water storage,
16 conveyance and delivery project;

17 20. to the Ramah water and sanitation district in
18 McKinley county for a water storage, conveyance and delivery
19 project;

20 21. to the town of Red River in Taos county for a
21 water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

22 22. to the Regina mutual domestic water consumers
23 association, incorporated, in Sandoval county for a water
24 storage, conveyance and delivery project;

25 23. to the village of Ruidoso in Lincoln county

1 for a water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

2 24. to the San Francisco soil and water
3 conservation district in Catron county for a watershed
4 restoration and management project;

5 25. to the San Juan soil and water conservation
6 district in San Juan county for a watershed restoration and
7 management project;

8 26. to the Sangre de Cristo regional mutual
9 domestic water consumers and mutual sewage works association
10 in Guadalupe county for a water storage, conveyance and
11 delivery project;

12 27. to the city of Santa Fe in Santa Fe county for
13 a water storage, conveyance and delivery project;

14 28. to the southern Sandoval county arroyo flood
15 control authority in Sandoval county for a flood
16 prevention project;

17 29. to the city of Sunland Park in Dona Ana county
18 for a flood prevention project;

19 30. to the Talpa mutual domestic water consumers
20 association in Taos county for a water storage, conveyance
21 and delivery project;

22 31. to the village of Tijeras in Bernalillo county
23 for a water storage, conveyance and delivery project; and

24 32. to the Williams Acres water and sanitation
25 district in McKinley county for a water storage, conveyance

1 and delivery project.

2 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
3 peace, health and safety that this act take effect
4 immediately. _____
