10 A JOINT RESOLUTION

11 PROPOSING TO AMEND ARTICLE 7 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO
12 TO ALLOW VOTERS WHO HAVE NOT SELECTED A PARTY AFFILIATION TO
13 VOTE IN THE PRIMARY ELECTION OF A POLITICAL PARTY AND PROVIDING
14 POLITICAL PARTIES THE OPTION OF ALLOWING ONLY PARTY MEMBERS TO
15 PARTICIPATE IN THE PARTY'S NOMINATION PROCESS ON CONDITION THAT
16 THE PARTY PAYS THE COSTS OF THAT PROCESS.

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

19 SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 7 of the
20 constitution of New Mexico by adding a new section to read:

21 "A political party that qualifies for and chooses to
22 participate in a state-sponsored and state-funded primary
23 election as provided by law shall allow a qualified elector who
24 is registered to vote, but has not selected a party affiliation
25 on the qualified elector's certificate of voter registration,

1 to vote in that party's primary election; provided that the
2 qualified elector may vote in only one party's primary
3 election; and provided further that a political party may
4 choose to nominate its candidates in a manner otherwise
5 provided by law that allows the party to limit participation in
6 the nomination process to members of the party if the party
7 pays all costs of the nomination process."

8 SECTION 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
9 shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
10 rejection at the next general election or at any special
11 election prior to that date that may be called for that
12 purpose.
