Your **CONSUMER & PUBLIC AFFAIRS COMMITTEE**, to whom
has been referred

HOUSE BILL 314

has had it under consideration and reports same with
recommendation that it **DO PASS**, amended as follows:

1. On page 2, line 17, strike "court or agency" and insert in
lieu thereof "public".

2. On page 2, line 25, after the period, strike the remainder
of the line and on page 3, strike lines 1 and 2 in their entirety.

3. On page 3, between lines 2 and 3, insert the following new
subsections:

"C. If an arrest or conviction involved cannabis and
non-cannabis charges, a person may request expungement of eligible
cannabis charges as defined in Subsection A of this section by the
administrative office of the courts through the procedure
implemented in Subsection B of this section.

D. Requests for expungement to the administrative office
of the courts from persons charged with offenses eligible for
automatic expungement shall remain confidential and are not subject
to disclosure."",
