11 RELATING TO MAGISTRATE RETIREMENT; CLARIFYING THAT A RETIRED  
12 MEMBER MAY FILE AN EXEMPTION FROM MEMBERSHIP UNDER THE  
13 MAGISTRATE RETIREMENT ACT.

14  
15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. Section 10-12C-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1992,  
17 Chapter 118, Section 4, as amended by Laws 2014, Chapter 39,  
18 Section 3 and by Laws 2014, Chapter 43, Section 3) is amended  
19 to read:

20 "10-12C-4. MEMBERSHIP.--~~Every~~ Unless an irrevocable  
21 exemption is filed pursuant to Subsection C of Section  
22 10-12C-16 NMSA 1978, every magistrate while in office shall  
23 become a member and shall be subject to the provisions of the  
24 Magistrate Retirement Act ~~[provided, however, that a magistrate~~  
25 ~~who, prior to July 1, 2014, applied for and received an~~

1 ~~exemption from membership shall not become a member until such~~  
2 ~~exemption ends]~~. A magistrate who is retired under any state  
3 system or the educational retirement system shall:

4           A. pay the applicable member contributions and the  
5 state, through the administrative office of the courts, shall  
6 pay the applicable employer contributions as provided pursuant  
7 to the Magistrate Retirement Act; and

8           B. not accrue a service credit and shall not be  
9 eligible to purchase service credit nor to retire pursuant to  
10 the Magistrate Retirement Act."

11           SECTION 2. Section 10-12C-8 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1992,  
12 Chapter 118, Section 8, as amended by Laws 2014, Chapter 39,  
13 Section 5 and by Laws 2014, Chapter 43, Section 5) is amended  
14 to read:

15           "10-12C-8. AGE AND SERVICE CREDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR NORMAL  
16 RETIREMENT.--

17           A. For a magistrate who was a member on June 30,  
18 2014, the age and service credit requirements for retirement  
19 provided for in the Magistrate Retirement Act are:

20                       (1) age sixty-five years or older and five or  
21 more years of service credit;

22                       (2) age sixty years or older and fifteen or  
23 more years of service credit; or

24                       (3) any age and twenty-four or more years of  
25 service credit.

1           B. For a magistrate who initially became a member  
2 on or after July 1, 2014, the age and service requirements for  
3 normal retirement provided for in the Magistrate Retirement Act  
4 are:

5                   (1) age sixty-five years or older and eight or  
6 more years of service credit;

7                   (2) age sixty years or older and fifteen or  
8 more years of service credit; or

9                   (3) any age and twenty-four or more years of  
10 service credit.

11           C. Except for a member who is retired under any  
12 state system or the educational retirement system, if a member  
13 leaves office for any reason, other than removal pursuant to  
14 Article 6, Section 32 of the constitution of New Mexico before  
15 meeting the age and service credit requirements for retirement  
16 pursuant to the provisions of this section and if that member  
17 leaves the member contributions on deposit in the fund, that  
18 member may apply for retirement when that member meets the age  
19 and service credit requirements for retirement pursuant to the  
20 provisions of the Magistrate Retirement Act or provisions of  
21 the Public Employees Retirement Reciprocity Act.

22           D. No member shall be eligible to receive a pension  
23 pursuant to the provisions of the Magistrate Retirement Act  
24 while ~~[still in office]~~ serving a term of office for which  
25 service credit is accrued."

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2023.
