AN ACT

RELATING TO GAMING CONTROL; INCREASING THE MAXIMUM AWARD OF A
GAMING MACHINE ON THE PREMISES OF A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION
GAMING OPERATOR LICENSEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 60-2E-28 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997,
Chapter 190, Section 30, as amended) is amended to read:

"60-2E-28. GAMING OPERATOR LICENSEES--SPECIAL
CONDITIONS FOR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS--NUMBER OF GAMING
MACHINES--DAYS AND HOURS OF OPERATIONS.--

A. A nonprofit organization may be issued a gaming
operator's license to operate licensed gaming machines on its
premises to be played only by active and auxiliary members.

B. No more than fifteen gaming machines may be
offered for play on the premises of a nonprofit organization
gaming operator licensee.

C. A gaming machine on the premises of a nonprofit
organization gaming operator licensee may not award a prize
that exceeds ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).

D. Gaming machines may be played on the premises
of a nonprofit organization gaming operator licensee from
12:00 noon until 12:00 midnight every day."_____
