SUMMARY

Synopsis of Senate Bill 153

Senate Bill 153 (SB153) requires the Legislative Council Services (LCS) to publish on the legislative website a searchable list of each appropriation contained in a supplemental general appropriation act that passes the Legislature after January 17, 2023. This shall include the name of each legislator who allocates a portion of each appropriation and the amount of the verified allocation. The list, including vetoes, shall be published 30 days after the adjournment of the legislative session in which the supplemental general appropriation act is approved by both chambers of the Legislature. The bill also defines a supplemental general appropriations act.

This bill contains an emergency clause and would become effective immediately on signature by the governor.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Previously, Legislative Council Service was able to publish a searchable list with the criteria contained in this bill within its operating budget; therefore, no additional impact is assumed at this time.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Supporters of this bill note it would improve transparency.
