56TH LEGISLATURE - STATE OF NEW MEXICO - SECOND SESSION, 2024

AN ACT

RELATING TO JUDICIAL SALARIES; PROVIDING THAT JUSTICES OF THE
STATE SUPREME COURT SHALL RECEIVE A SALARY INCREASE; REMOVING
SALARY FORMULAS FOR MAGISTRATES; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 34-1-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,
Chapter 278, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"34-1-9. SALARIES OF JUSTICES, JUDGES AND MAGISTRATES.--

A. Justices of the supreme court shall each receive
an annual salary [~~as provided by the legislature~~] of two
hundred thirty-two thousand six hundred dollars (\$232,600)
beginning July 1, 2024. The chief justice of the supreme court
shall receive an annual salary that is two thousand dollars
(\$2,000) more than the annual salary of a justice of the
supreme court.

2 (1) the court of appeals shall receive an
3 annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual salary
4 of the chief justice of the supreme court;

5 (2) a district court shall receive an annual

7 chief judge of the court of appeals; and

8 (3) a metropolitan court shall receive an
9 annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual salary
10 of the chief judge of a district court.

23 (2) a district court judge shall receive an
24 annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual salary
25 of a judge of the court of appeals; and

1 (3) a metropolitan court judge shall receive
2 an annual salary that is ninety-five percent of the annual
3 salary of a district court judge.

25 in the Per Diem and Mileage Act."
