BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

HB 19 enacts the Trade Port Development Act which will 1) establish criteria for trade port districts and trade port projects, 2) create the trade ports advisory committee, 3) establish the duties of the trade ports advisory committee and the Secretary of the advisory committee, 4) establishes requirements and restrictions of public-private partnerships, 5) creates the trade port development fund, 6) establishes the reporting requirements for the annual report prepared by advisory committee, 7) amends the Tax Administration Act to establish distributions to the trade ports development fund, amounting to 1% of the net receipts from the gross receipts tax, 8) amends Section 7-14-10 NMSA to change the distribution of the motor vehicle excise tax, and 9) creates exemptions to the procurement code
