BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: The proposed legislation is an Act related to accessibility, which requires commercial places of public amusement, such as an auditorium, a convention center, a cultural complex, an exhibition hall, a permanent amusement park, a sports arena, a theater or a movie house for which the maximum occupancy is determined to be two thousand five hundred (2500) or more people, install universal powered, height-adjustable adult changing stations in a single-occupancy restroom that is universal to gender and available to the public.
