BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: This bill requires both developers and users of any artificial intelligence system to take detailed affirmative steps surrounding cybersecurity and risk of algorithmic discrimination.

The bill grants enforcement and rule-making authority to the New Mexico Department of Justice, which must develop a risk management framework and reporting requirements for developers and users.
