#### **BILL SUMMARY**

<u>Synopsis:</u> aims to expand the state's nondiscrimination policy concerning eligibility for post-secondary tuition rates and state-funded financial aid. The bill mandates that any tuition rates or state-funded financial aid available to New Mexico residents must also be granted, regardless of immigration status, to individuals who meet any of the following criteria:

- 1. Secondary Education in New Mexico:
