#### **BILL SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis:

House Bill 74 (HB74) would create the "Firefighter and Emergency Service Provider Peer Support Act" authorizing any state, local or regional public fire agency to establish a peer support program to provide support services to employees of those agencies who are dealing with a variety of emotional and mental health issues including critical incident stress, grief support and other listed issues. The Act would also provide for confidentiality regarding information/counseling of individuals participating in the support program and limited liability for team members volunteering under the program.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There is no anticipated fiscal impact on the RLD if HB 74 were to be enacted.

The Regulation & Licensing Department (RLD) does not directly regulate or license any of the affected public fire agencies or professions impacted by HB 74. Likewise, none of the state licensing boards or commissions administratively attached to the RLD regulate or license any of the affected public fire agencies or professions dealt with under the bill.
