#### **BILL SUMMARY**

##### Synopsis:

HB86 will remove the time limit for commencing prosecution of human trafficking, increase the age for sexual exploitation of children by prostitution from sixteen to eighteen, adds human trafficking to the definition of racketeering, amends the elements of human trafficking, provides a definition of harm, prohibits certain defenses in a prosecution for human trafficking, adds victims of human trafficking and sexual exploitation of children to the victims of crime act. And prohibits earned meritorious deductions for a human trafficking sentence.
