BILL SUMMARY

HB 109 creates the extreme weather resiliency fund. \$12MM is appropriated to the fund and any unexpended or unencumbered balances will revert to the general fund at the end of FY28. Money in the fund will be used to provide grants to political subdivisions of the state, Indian nations, tribes or pueblos to prepare for and respond to public health emergencies related to extreme weather and other climate impacts.
