Synopsis:

HB117- Amends the Vital Statistics Act to add physician assistants to the medical professionals who may routinely sign a death certificate. In the absence of a physician, nurse practitioner or physician assistant, the amended section would permit the medical certification of death to be signed by the physician assistant's associate physician assistant, among other appropriate auxiliary medical personnel currently authorized under existing law to sign.
