#### **BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis:

HB 147 proposes to add a thirty-first judgeship to the Second Judicial District.

Section 1 of the bill amends the number of judges in the Second Judicial District from "thirty" to "thirty-one" in NMSA 1978, Section 34-6-5.

Section 2 of the bill appropriates \$306,800 from the general fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2026 to cover costs of the new judgeship, including salaries and benefits for judge and staff.
