BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

HB155 Amends Section 60-2E-9 NMSA 1978, Chapter 190, Section 11 to revise the level of administrative experience to be with a regulatory agency or gaming industry. While the Executive Director salary is still set by the board, HB155 strikes the requirement that

the salary not exceed the governor of New Mexico's salary.
