### **BILL SUMMARY**

<u>Synopsis:</u> This bill proposes adjustments to New Mexico's Public School Finance Act by creating additional program units for educators with bilingual and TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) endorsements. The additional program unit would result in a one-time salary differential for those licensed school employees.

# FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no fiscal implications for Indian Affairs Department.

### **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

IAD does not have technical or substantive expertise in this area and therefore defers to PED. IAD does however note that the bill could ensure that licensed school employees who have a bilingual endorsement, including those with a bilingual endorsement in a Native American language, would be able to access the one-time salary differential.
