Synopsis: House Bill 249 amends the Unemployment Compensation Law, NMSA 1978, Section 51-1-5, allowing the Secretary of Workforce Solutions to waive the one week waiting period requirement for eligibility for benefits in the event of a federal or state emergency or disaster declaration.
