BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: House Bill 321 would create a higher level of careless driving with a higher penalty: careless driving that results in death or great bodily harm to another constitutes a misdemeanor and carries a penalty of imprisonment in the county jail for a definite term less than one year or a fine of no more than \$1,000, or both. Defines great bodily harm as an injury that creates a high probability of death, that causes serious disfigurement or that causes loss of function of any member or organ of the body.

Effective date: July 1, 2025.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Any increase in penalty for careless driving that results in death or great bodily harm to another would likely affect the department in the number of individuals sentenced to prison or community supervision because of NMSA 1978, Sections 31-19-1 and 33-2-39, but the department's resources would likely be sufficient to handle the increase without causing significant fiscal strain.
