SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

The bill creates an Interim Administrative Rule Oversight Committee comprised of twelve legislators and up to four staff. The purpose of the committee is to review and make recommendations regarding administrative rules proposed by executive agencies prior to public hearings on the rules. The committee also would review authorizing statutes and make recommendations for amendments. The bill would require agencies to provide the committee with fiscal impact statements for any rule with an estimated cost greater than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) and, if requested, any rule with an estimated cost less than one million dollars (1,000,000.00). The fiscal impact statement is also to be included in an agency's public notice of rule making and published in the New Mexico Register.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The bill appropriates two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in FY 2026 for the staffing and operations of the committee but does not appropriate any funds for any additional costs that may be incurred by the agencies in complying with it.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The bill would provide the legislature with more information about administrative rules and give them an opportunity to provide input but would not otherwise alter the rule making process.
