BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis:</u> House Bill 547 would amend the Criminal Sentencing Code to provide that for a defendant convicted of a serious violent offense the judge may only consider aggravating circumstances when deciding to alter a basic sentence prescribed for a crime.

This would remove judges' discretion to reduce the basic sentences for defendants convicted of serious violent offenses.
