BILL SUMMARY

HM2 creates a working group to study, through a Data Governance framework, the current landscape of educational data across several state agencies including the Public Education Department, the Higher Education Department, the Early Childhood Education and Care Department, the Children, Youth and Families Department, the Workforce Solutions Department, the Vocational Rehabilitation Division of the Public Education Department and the Department of Information Technology. The working group will study and report on seven key areas that impact data quality, access to data through timely reports, stakeholders' data needs, interoperability frameworks, data privacy and security, establishment of formal data governance structures. The working group will also address the use of AI by schools and educators and will recommend policies for AI in public schools. The work of the group will culminate in a report due October 31, 2025.
