BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: SB11 is an Act that requires the Public Education Department to encourage school districts and charter schools to adopt Anti-Distraction Policies that restrict student use of personal electronic devices during the school day to promote academic success and positive social development of students. SB11 also requests an appropriation of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) to reimburse school districts and charter schools for specialized storage equipment associated with the implementation of the policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

No foreseeable fiscal implications to ECECD. SB11 appropriates ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from the general fund to the Public Education Department to reimburse school districts and charter schools for acquisition of specialized storage equipment associated with implementation of an anti-distraction policy in the fiscal years of 2026 through 2028.
