### **BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis:

This bill amends section 13-4D-5 of the Public Works Apprentice and Training Act by removing the exemption for street, highway, bridge, road, utility, or maintenance contracts with employers who choose not to participate in training. The new language ensures that all public works projects require participating employers to contribute to approved apprentice and training programs or to the Public Works Apprentice and Training Fund.
