Synopsis: Senate Bill 24 (SB24)

SB24 amends the Public Works Apprentice and Training Act, to require all employers working on public works construction projects, without exception, to make contributions to an approved New Mexico apprentice and training program. This bill does not directly affect the Regulation and Licensing Department.
