#### **BILL SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis:

This bill would make a one-time non-recurring appropriation of two hundred and twenty-two million dollars (\$222,000,000) to capitalize the existing statutory Water Project Fund created in the New Mexico Finance Authority. The statutory purpose of this fund is to make loans or grants to qualified entities for water resource and infrastructure projects pursuant to the provisions of the Water Project Finance Act (WPFA) including water rights adjudications.

This bill would have a direct fiscal impact of significantly increasing the amount of funding available to allocate to statewide WPFA projects. It could result in a corresponding minor indirect fiscal and operational impact lasing one or more years for the entities involved in the awarding and management of the increased volume of projects. Impacted entities include the Water Trust Board, the New Mexico Finance Authority, and those agencies which provide technical project review assistance under the WPFA. It would also increase the amount of funding available for distribution to the Office of the State Engineer and the Administrative Office of the Courts for water rights adjudications.
