The Community Benefit Fund (SB48) transfers \$360 million from the GF to the Community Benefit Fund, created by this act. Money in the Community Benefit Fund may be appropriated for projects that address climate change in specified ways. DFA administers the Community Benefit Fund.

Pg. 1, line 25. Suggest "reduce a or multiple greenhouse gases;"

Pg. 5, line 6-11. Suggest the same definition of greenhouse gas as proposed in SB4: "means gaseous compounds that absorb infrared radiation emitted from the earth's surface and trap heat in the earth's atmosphere, including carbon dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide, hydrofluorocarbons, perfluorocarbons, nitrogen trifluoride and sulfur hexafluoride, but not including water vapor;"
