BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

SB160 will require each school district and charter school to adopt and implement a policy for the use of wireless communication devices by students in public schools. Requiring the Public Education Department to provide policy guidelines and policy evaluations.

No later than August 1, 2025, each school district and charter school shall adopt and implement a wireless communication device policy. The Public Education Department shall issue guidelines outlining the minimum requirements for a wireless communication device policy. School districts and charter schools shall annually evaluate the effectiveness of their wireless communication device policies and report the findings to the Public Education Department. School districts and charter schools shall provide training for teachers, administrators, and staff on the effective implementation of the wireless communication device policy, and the policy shall be communicated to students, and parents upon implementation and on an ongoing basis at the beginning of each school year.

The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2025.
