#### **BILL SUMMARY**

Synopsis:

SB 165 amends the Public Employees Retirement Act [NMSA 1978 10-11-8] to allow retired members to return to work as certified lifeguards without suspension of their pension benefits.

## **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

Because the statute requires return to work members and their employers to pay contributions it may have a very small positive impact to the funding ratio of the Municipal General fund. For the year ending June 30, 2024, the Municipal General fund ratio is 73.50%. The bill is currently undergoing an actuarial analysis for its impact to the fund.

SB 165 should not have an impact to PERA's operating budget.
