SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

SB0188 appropriates \$100,000 to the Energy Minerals and Natural Resources Department (EMNRD) to create a link on the EMNRD website that directs a user to a page on the N.M. Department of Justice website where they can view complaints filed against rooftop solar panel installers and find instruction for consumers to file complaints against rooftop solar panel installers.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

EMNRD will use the appropriation to fund the staff time needed from ECAM and ITO to design and publish the required link.

Since the more significant obligation rests with the DOJ, EMNRD presumes that it would pursue an MOU to transfer some of the appropriation to DOJ to build and maintain the proposed web page.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

This bill may deter dishonest business practices by increasing transparency and oversight of solar installers by more closely connecting the state departments concerned with consumer solar installations.

However, this bill does not explicitly compel the DOJ to build and maintain the DOJ website contemplated here; the legislature may wish to add that language.
